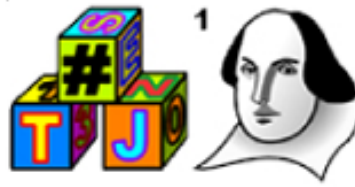

## **Celebrate ISAAC's International AAC Awareness Month**

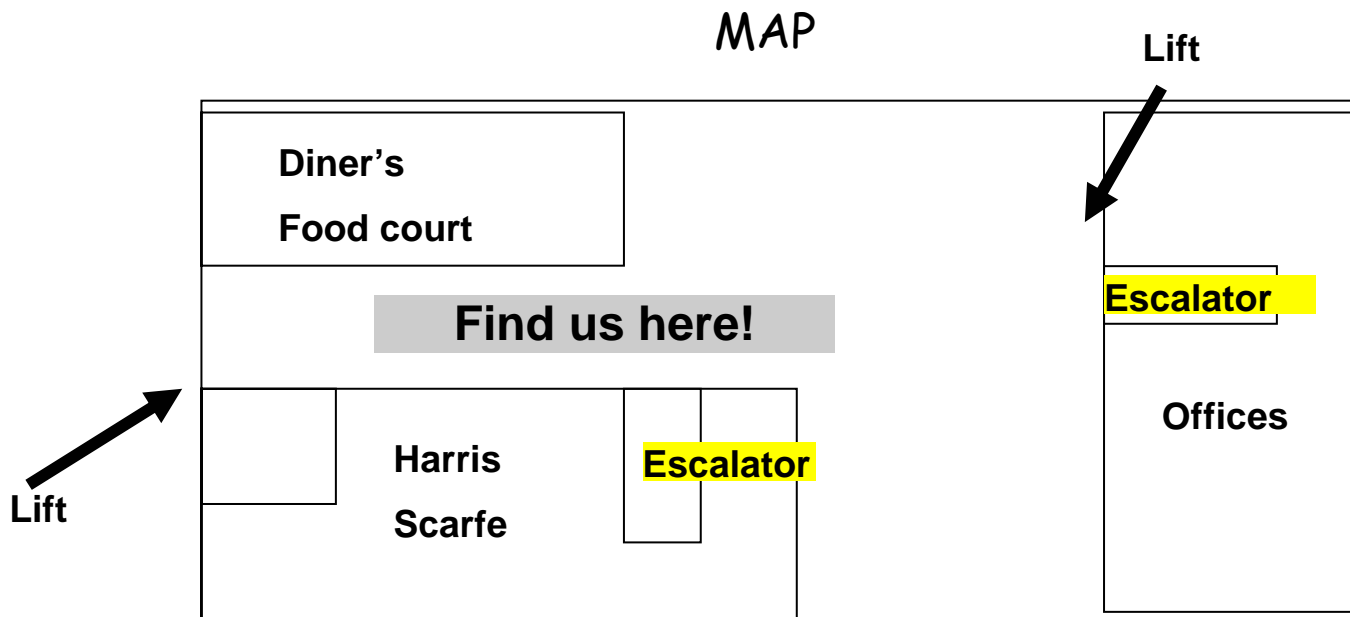
